THE SEASON OF LENT EXTENDS THIS YEAR FROM WEDNESDAY, MARCH 2 TO THE MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER APRIL 14 INCLUSIVE. #1 Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays of Lent. #2 Everyone 18 years of age & under 59 years of age is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. #3 On these two days of fast & abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. #4 When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law is modified. Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill, including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting. #5 Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices.
